Since 2018 the Livelihoods and Agricultural Infrastructure Development (LAID) Project, which is funded by KfW (German Development Bank) and World Vision (11 Mio. Euro total Project volume), is implemented with the overall objective to increase the stability and economic well-being of 37,430 conflict affected households in 5 localities of South Darfur State by increasing access to diversified sources of livelihoods and improvement of rural infrastructures and basic services. The objective of the Consultant's assignment is to support World Vision Germany and World Vision Sudan (as Project Executing Agency) in the function of a Technical Advisor and Short Term Expert for the implementation of a small scale water harvesting and irrigation infrastructures component.
